<p><b>Bookings:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only Seacourt members &amp; their guests allowed to play. No spectators permitted.</li> <li>• The courts may only be used if a booking has been made through the published process.</li> </ul> <p><b>Arrivals and departures:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Players should only come to the club if they, and all members of their household are well.</li> <li>• Players should arrive only shortly before their playing time and leave the club immediately after coming off court with no socializing in the adjacent areas or car park. If refreshment or a meal have been ordered after play, entry to the bar must be via the RT corridor &amp; wait to be taken to the booked table.</li> <li>• Entry and exit to the Sports Hall will be via the door adjacent to E court, sanitizing hands with the sanitizer provided at the door.</li> </ul> <p><b>Social distancing:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social distancing must be observed from the moment players arrive at the premises.</li> <li>• While doubles is allowed, players should attempt to remain apart as much as is reasonably practicable.</li> </ul> <p><b>Fomite transmission (surfaces);</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shuttlecocks and racquets must be provided by the players</li> <li>• Drinks must be brought by players. Soft drinks only.</li> <li>• Players must bring their own hand sanitizer and sanitize frequently, particularly when taking drinks breaks and leaving the court.</li> <li>• If the padded seating is used, it must be wiped down with the cleaning fluid provided before leaving the hall.</li> </ul>
