<p>Booking:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only Seacourt members & their guests allowed to play. No spectators permitted. • The courts may only be used if a booking has been made through the published process. <p>Arrivals and departures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players must only come to the club if they and all members of their household are fit and well. • Players should arrive only shortly before their playing time and leave the club immediately after coming off court with no socializing in the adjacent areas or car park. If refreshment or a meal have been ordered after play, entry to the bar must be via the RT corridor & wait to be taken to the booked table. • Entry and exit for play will be via the door adjacent to E court. Sanitize when arriving and leaving, using the sanitizer provided at the entrance. <p>Social distancing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social distancing must be observed from the moment players arrive at the premises. • There will be no change of ends. To assist with social distancing, players should elect, before play, begins, who will take 50/50 balls. <p>Fomite (surface to surface transmission);</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Balls and racquets must be provided by the players. • Drinks must be brought by players. Soft drinks only. • Players must bring their own hand sanitizer and sanitize frequently, particularly when taking drinks breaks. Players must wipe down the door and its handle with the wipes and cleaning fluid provided after play. <p>Airborne transmission:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players to leave the door open at end of play to assist with ventilation and air changes. • While not considered necessary, players may choose to wear face masks but, if they do so, it is important to remember not to touch it until final removal. <p>First aid:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be no first aid facilities available at certain times and members must immediately call 999 in the event of a serious medical emergency.
