DETAILS OF THE HAZARD(S) IDENTIFIED:			
Contact with the Covid 19 virus via: Person to person via contact, coughs, sneezes, speech etc. Fomite (transmission from a contaminated surface), Aerosol transmission.

PRECAUTIONS ALREADY TAKEN TO REDUCE THE RISK:			
Bookings:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only Seacourt members & their guests allowed to play. No spectators permitted. • The courts may only be used if a booking has been made through the published process. 			
Arrivals and departures:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Players should arrive only shortly before their playing time and leave the club immediately after coming off court with no socializing in the adjacent areas or car park. • Separate entrances and exits will be used for the 2 courts. • No entry to the club unless a table has been booked in advance. 			
Social distancing:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social distancing must be observed from the moment players arrive at the premises, particularly during changeovers. 			
Fomite transmission (Surface to surface)			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sanitizer must be used immediately after going through the gate to the court and immediately after going through the gate when leaving court. • Players must bring their own hand sanitizer. It would be prudent to use sanitizer periodically at players' discretion, particularly at drinks breaks. • In a coaching session, balls will be provided by the Lawn Tennis Professional and frequent hand sanitizing is recommended. • Drinks must be brought by players. Soft drinks only. • Balls from the adjacent court to be returned along the ground using a racquet. • While not considered necessary, players may choose to wear gloves and face masks. • The Lawn Tennis Professional will clean down common surfaces such as gate latches on a regular basis. 			
First aid:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be no first aid facilities available at certain times. In this case, players must immediately call 999 in the event of a serious medical emergency.
